A BRIEF CHRONOLOGY OF LAST THINGS

FROM A DISPENSATIONAL APPROACH

- 1. The **Church Age**. (Rev. 2:1-3:22; Isa. 28:11; Acts 2:1-12; cf. 1 Cor. 14:20-22; Matt. 16:18; 1 Pet. 2:5, 9, 10; Gal. 3:26-29; Eph. 1:22, 23; 3:1-11; 5:32)
- 2. The **Regathering of Israel** [national restoration]. (Ezek. 20:33-38; 36:23-24; Ezek. 37:1-14; Rom. 11:25-27; cf. the *"parable of the fig tree"* Matt. 24:32-34)
- 3. The **Rapture** of the Church. (Rev. 4:1, 2; 1 Thess. 4:13-18; 1 Cor. 1:7, 8; 15:51, 52; Titus 2:13; John 14:1-3; Rev. 3:10; 21:10ff; 22:14-17)
- 4. The Church in Heaven:
 - a. The *"judgement seat"* of Jesus Christ. (1 Cor. 3:12-15; 4:1-5; 9:24-27; 2 Cor. 5:10; Rom. 14:10)
 - b. After the Rapture and during the seven years of tribulation on the earth. (Rev. 4:1-5:10)
 - c. Being prepared as the **Bride of Christ**, "the bride, the wife of the Lamb." (2 Cor. 11:2; Rev. 19:9; 22:17)
- 5. The **seven year** future time period known as the *"tribulation."* (Dan. 9:27; Matt. 24:9-29; Mk. 13:9-23; Rev. 6:1-11:14; 12:1-14:13; Rev. 15:5-16:12; Rev. 17:1-18:24; cf. Ezek. 38:1-39:6)
 - a. **Antichrist**, the "beast...out of the sea," and the **False Prophet**, the "beast... out of the earth," revealed. (2 Thess. 2:3-11; Rev. 13:1-13)
 - b. The "seven seals" of the book of judgment. (Rev. 6:1-17; 8:1-5)
 - c. The **144,000 Israelite** evangelists are saved and sealed. (Rev. 7:1-8)
 - d. The "seven trumpets" of judgment. (Rev. 8:7-11:19)
 - e. The "two witnesses," probably Moses and Elijah, prophesy. (Rev. 11:3-12)
 - f. The "abomination of desolation" standing in the holy place. (Dan. 9:27; 11:31; Matt. 24:15-20; Mk. 13:14; Rev. 13:14-18)
 - g. The "mark...of the beast," the name or the number of the beast, 666, is caused to be given to all men. (Rev. 13:16-18)
 - h. Then there will be a "great tribulation," the last three and a half years of the "tribulation." (Matt. 24:21-29; Dan. 12:1; Rev. 7:14)
 - i. The "seven golden bowls" of judgement. (Rev. 15:1-16:21)
 - j. "Mystery Babylon the Great." (Rev. 17:1-18:24)
- 6. The **Battle of Armageddon** begins:
 - a. The whole world is **gathered together** for war against Jerusalem. (Ezek. 38:1-8; Zech. 12:3; Rev. 16:13-16; Zech. 14:2; Joel 3:9-17)
 - b. **Antichrist's last stand**. (Daniel 7:21, 25; 11:36-45; cf. Ezek. 38:9-17, together with the King of the North, Gog)

- 7. The **Second Advent** of the Lord Jesus Christ:
 - a. He is "coming with the clouds of heaven." (Daniel 7:13a; Matt. 16:27; 24:29-31; Rev. 1:7, 8; 14:14; cf. Col. 3:4)
 - b. He meets the 144,000 Evangelists on "*Mount Zion*." (Rev. 14:1-5; Psa. 110:1; "*Mount of Olives*," Zech. 14:4-5; Heb. 1:13; 10:12, 13)
 - c. He comes **to judge and make war**. (Isa. 66:14-16; Ezek. 38:18-20; Zech. 12:4, 9; 14:3; Rev. 19:11-14)
 - d. "Three angelic messengers" preach the "everlasting gospel." (Rev. 14:6-13)
 - e. Jesus Christ is **victorious over the Beast** (Antichrist) and his armies. (Dan. 9:27d; Rev. 19:15-21; 2 Thess. 2:8, 9; cf. Isa. 11:4c, d; Ezek. 38:21-39:6)
- 8. The mobile **Courtroom of the Ancient of Days** is set up as part of the second advent of the Lord Jesus Christ. (Daniel 7:9, 10, 22a; Rev. 3:21; 4:4, 10; 5:10; 11:16; 20:4; Matt. 19:28; Lk. 22:30)
- 9. The **Tribulation Martyrs** in Heaven. (Rev. 7:9-17; 15:1-4)
- 10. The **Antichrist**, "the beast out of the sea," and the false prophet are judged and sentenced. (Dan. 7:26, 11; Rev. 19:20; 20:10)
- 11. **Satan is bound** in the abyss for a thousand years. (Rev. 20:1-3)
- 12. **Judgement** is passed **in favor of the saints**. (Dan. 7:22b; 12:1; Ezek. 20:41-44; Matt. 16:27; Rev. 20:4a)
- 13. The **Judgement of the nations**. (Dan. 7:12; Matt. 16:27; 25:32, 33; 1 Cor. 6:2, 3; Rev. 11:18, 19; Rev. 14:14-20; 16:16-21; 19:15, 21; cf. Ezek. 39:7-21)
- 14. The Presentation of the Lord Jesus Christ, "the Son of Man," to "the Ancient of Days," God the Father. (Daniel 7:13, 14; Ezek. 39:22-29; Rev. 11:15; 12:10)
- 15. The **Presentation of the Kingdom** to the Lord Jesus Christ by "the Ancient of Days." (Daniel 7:14; Rev. 5:11-14; cf. Phil. 2:9-11)
- 16. The **Saints** of the Highest One **receive the Kingdom** and **reign with Jesus Christ** in resurrection bodies on the earth for 1000 years. (Daniel 7:18, 22c, 27; Matt. 25:34)
 - a. Church Age Saints (Rev. 1:6; 2:25-27; 20:4a, 6)
 - b. Old Testament Saints (Dan. 7:22c; 12:2, 12, 13; Rev. 11:18b; Ezek. 20:15-28; Ezek. 20:37, 40)
 - c. Tribulation Martyrs (Dan. 7:22c; 12:2, 12; Rev. 11:18b; 20:4b, 6; Ezek. 20:40)
- 17. The **Millennial Kingdom begins** on earth. (Rev. 11:15-17; Ezek. 40:1-48:35; Zech. 14:9-11; Dan. 12:3; cf. "*a new covenant*" Jer. 31:31; Isa. 59:20, 21; Rom. 11:26, 27; Heb. 8:8-13)

- 18. Satan is **released from prison** for a short time. (Rev. 20:3b, 7, 8a)
- 19. Satan **deceives the nations** again and **gathers them for the war** of "*Gog and Magog.*" (Rev. 20:8b, 9a; <u>NOTE</u>: This is not the same as the Battle of Armageddon, see pt.#7)
- 20. God's Judgement upon the last human revolt. "...and fire came down from heaven and devoured them." (Rev. 20:9b)
- 21. Satan, the Devil, was "cast into the lake of fire." (Rev. 20:10)
- 22. The **Great White Throne** judgement follows. (Rev. 20:11-15)
 - a. The "books of works" (Rev. 20:12
 - b. The "book of life" (Rev. 20:12; 21:27)
 - c. The second death is "the lake of fire." (Rev. 20:14, 15)
- 23. The **new heavens**, the **new earth**, the **new Jerusalem**, and the **eternal state** are described last. (Rev. 21:1-22:5; 2 Pet. 3:10-13; cf. Isa. 65:17, 18; 66:22)
