BELIEVER'S JOB DESCRIPTION

- 1. Believers in Jesus Christ are to be <u>well-pleasing</u> (εὐάρεστος) to God. (2 Cor.5:9) (εὐάρεστος euarestos Greek adj. meaning: well-pleasing, acceptable)
- 2. Believers must <u>please</u> God by faith, because "without faith it is impossible <u>to</u> <u>please</u> God." (Heb. 11:6; cf. Heb. 11:5 Enoch was <u>well-pleasing</u> to God.)
- 3. Believers **must discover** what is **well-pleasing** to God. (Rom. 12:2)
- 4. Believers **must learn** (examine) what is **well- pleasing** to God. (Eph. 5:8b-10)
- 5. Believers **must present their bodies** "a living sacrifice, holy, **well-pleasing** to God." (Rom. 12:1; cf. Heb 13:16)
- 6. Believers **must serve** (Jesus Christ) in these, "righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit," to be "<u>well-pleasing</u> (εὐαρεστέω) to God and acceptable to men." (Rom. 14:17, 18; cf. Heb. 12:28; 13:20, 21) (εὐαρεστέω Gk. verb meaning: to please, to be well-pleasing)
- 7. Believers **must practice** the things that are **pleasing** in His sight. (1 Thess. 4:1; 1 John 3:22)
