# FALSE MEANS OF SALVATION FROM CONDEMNATION (PHASE #1)

- 1. Invite Christ into your heart. (Rev. 3:20)
- 2. Invite Christ into your life. (Rev. 3:20)
- 3. Believe and be baptized. (Mk. 16:16; Acts 22:16; 1 Pet. 3:21)
- 4. Believe and confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord. (Rom. 10:9, 10)
- 5. Call upon the name of the Lord. (Acts 22:16; Rom. 10:13, 14; cf. Joel 2:32)
- 6. Believe and overcome. (Rev. 2:7, 11, 17, 26; 3:5, 12, 21; 1 Jn. 5:4, 5)
- 7. Believe and obey the Lord. (John 3:36; Heb. 5:9; 1 Peter 4:17)
- 8. Believe and endure (persevere) to the end. (Matt. 10:22; 24:13; Mk. 13:13)
- 9. Believe and demonstrate good works. (Phil 2:12; Eph. 2:8-10; Titus 3:5-7)
- 10. Repent and believe. (Mark 1:15; Acts 2:38-44)
- 11. Confess your sins and believe. (1 John 1:9)
- 12. Pray the sinner's prayer. (Rom. 10:13 is for believers)

# BIBLICAL MEANS OF SALVATION FROM CONDEMNATION (PHASE #1) (The Person and the Essential Content of the Gospel)

# 1. <u>The Lord Jesus Christ</u> - the **person** who saves

"Believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, and you shall be saved,..." (Acts 16:31)

"These have been written that you may believe that <u>Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God</u>; and believing you may have everlasting life." (John 20:31)

Other verses stating <u>belief (faith) alone in Jesus Christ alone</u> for salvation from condemnation and for everlasting life:

(Mark 16:16; Luke 8:12; John 1:12; 3:16, 18, 36; 4:39, 41, 42; 5:38; 6:29, 40, 47; John 7:38, 39; 9:35, 36, 38; 11:25, 26, 27, 45, 48; 12:36; 14:1; 17:20; 20:31;

Acts 10:43; 11:17, 21; 13:39; 14:1; 15:5, 7, 11; 17:12, 34; Romans 3:22; 9:33; Romans 10:4, 11; (cf. Isa. 28:16); 1 Cor. 1:21; 1 John 3:23; 5:1, 5, 13)

Jesus Christ is eternal God, the second person of the trinity. (John 1:1-3, 10;10:30; 1 Cor. 4:4; 8:6; Col. 1:15-17; Heb. 1:2, 3, 8)

Jesus Christ is true humanity, yet without sin. (John 1:14; Rom. 8:3; Phil. 2:5-8; Heb. 2:17; 1 or. 5:21; Heb. 4:15; 1 Pet. 2:22; 1 John 3:5))

#### 2. He is the Son of God who died and rose again. - the event that saves

"Yes, Lord; I have believed that You are the Christ, the Son of God, even He who comes into the world." (John 11:27)

"I determined to know nothing among you except <u>Jesus Christ and Him crucified</u>." (1 Cor. 2:2)

"For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that <u>Christ died</u> for our sins according to the scriptures, and that He was buried, and that <u>He was raised on the third day</u> according to the scriptures," (1 Cor. 15:3, 4)

#### 3. He died to pay man's personal penalty for sin - the work that saves

"Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world." (John 1:29)

"And <u>He Himself bore our sins</u> in His own body on the cross..." (1 Pet. 2:24; Isa. 53: 4-6, 10-15)

"Everyone who believes in Him has received <u>forgiveness of sins</u>." (Matt. 26:228; Lk. 1:77; Acts 10:43

# **4.** He is the one who gives eternal life - the result of salvation

"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten (uniquely appointed) Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but <u>have eternal life</u>." (John 3:16)

"These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, in order that you may know that you have eternal life." (1 John 5:13)

Jesus Christ gives everlasting life. (John 7:2; 10:28; 1 John 5:12, 13)

# 5. <u>He alone is the savior</u> - the only one who saves

"Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me." (John 14:6)

"And there is <u>salvation in no one else</u>; for there is <u>no other name</u> under heaven that has been given among men, by which we must be saved." (Acts 4:12) "<u>Believe in the Lord Jesus Christ</u> and you will be saved." (Acts 16:31)
