THE WILL OF GOD

- 1. "The will of God is that which is good, and well pleasing, and perfect." (Rom. 12:2)
- <u>The will of God</u> was **fulfilled by Jesus Chris**t when he offered His body once for all (time). (Heb. 10:5-12; cf. Jn. 6:38) Jesus **died for all mankind** (2 Cor. 5:14, 15); **for the sins of the whole world**. (1 John 2:2)
- 3. <u>The will of God</u> is *"that everyone who beholds the Son, and believes in Him, may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up on the last day."* (John 6:39, 40)
- 4. <u>The will of the Lord</u> is that we should "*walk...as wise* men, *making the most of* our *time...be filled with the Spirit*." (Eph. 5:17, 18; cf. Col. 4:5; 1 Thess. 4:1)
- 5. <u>The will of God</u> is our sanctification (being set apart for God's special purpose) specifically that we "*abstain from sexual immorality*, that we *maintain* our *own bodies in sanctification and honor, not in lustful passion,* and that we do not *transgress and defraud our brother.*" (1 Thess. 4:3-6)
- 6. <u>The will of God</u> is that we should *"Rejoice always; pray without ceasing;* and *in everything give thanks."* (1 Thess. 5:16-18; cf. 1 John 5:14; Eph. 5:20)
- 7. <u>The will of God</u> is that we should be "*doing* what is *right* that we *may silence the ignorance of foolish men.*" (1 Pet. 2:15; 3:16)
- 8. <u>The will of God</u> is "*that* we should suffer for doing what is right rather than for doing what is wrong, if God should will it so." (1 Pet. 3:17; cf. 1 Pet.4:12-16, 19)
- 9. <u>The will of God</u> is fulfilled in us as God's indwelling and filling equips us *"in every good thing...working in us that which is pleasing in His sight., through Jesus Christ;"* (Heb. 13:21; cf. Phil. 2:13; Rom. 8:9-11, 14)
- 10. <u>The will of God</u> (His divine desire) is that "*all men should be saved* and to come to *the knowledge of the truth*." (1 Tim. 2:4) God does "*not desire for any to perish but for all to come to repentance*." (2 Pet. 3:9)
- 11. <u>The will of God</u> is that the Lord Jesus Christ "will deliver us out of this present evil Age (at the Rapture of the church)" (Gal. 1:4)

12.<u>The will of God</u> is to be **understood by all believers** "*in all spiritual wisdom and understanding so that you may* **walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please Him** *in all respects,* **bearing fruit** *in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God.*" (Col. 1:9, 10; cf. 1 Pet. 4:2)
